ilk: Chenopodiaceae

Species: Baby Spinach.

French: Pouesse d'Epinard;

Italian: Spinacino;

Spanish: Baby espinaca;

German: Spinat

Origin and diffusion:

The baby spinach , sown thickly in the greenhouse, is harvested by the collar so as to remove only the leaf. It has smooth leaves and is eaten raw.

It grows really fast (even at low temperatures), excellent quality of the leaf, erect growth habit, suitable for production in the colder periods of the year and appropriate for fresh market and industry.

Leaves are oval, smooth dark green and with quite thick.
